

## 2025 Summer Research Fellowship on LGBTQ Law and Policy

For the summer of 2025, the Williams Institute will award up to four Summer Fellowships to provide students (upper-level undergraduate and graduate) with opportunities to learn about and engage in social science research related to LGBTQ law and policy, global and domestic, with Williams Institute scholars. The Fellowship program is a mentorship and learning experience that will provide students exposure to public policy, research, analysis, and writing on issues impacting LGBTQ people and communities in the U.S. and worldwide. Sample topics could include:

- health and well-being of diverse LGBTQ populations (domestically and internationally)
- democratic erosion and LGBTI acceptance,
- political representation and engagement of LGBTQ people,
- LGBTQ refugees and asylum seekers,
- LGBTQ human rights by country and region,
- Artificial Intelligence and LGBTQ rights
- · climate change and marginalized communities,
- tax policy and LGBTQ families.

Summer fellows will receive a stipend of \$6,000 and are expected to work full-time for 8 weeks with the Williams Institute. The fellowship will be a remote-work position, but fellows are expected to be available during working hours (Pacific Time). Precise start and end dates are flexible.

#### **Criteria for Selection**

Applicants must be UCLA upper-level undergraduate or graduate students during the entire period of the fellowship. The Selection Committee will consider the following when evaluating applicants: a) research and writing abilities; b) academic record; and c) demonstrated commitment to work focused on sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, and sex characteristics law and policy issues.

To apply, please submit a cover letter addressing your interest in the fellowship and your relevant experience (no more than 500 words), your resume, your academic transcript, a writing sample, and the signed and initialed form below.

The application deadline is **Friday, March 21, 2025, at 5 pm (PT)**. Applicants will be considered on a rolling basis, so early applications are recommended.
