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APPENDIX

Detailed Survey Findings

The following tables contain unweighted tabulations for the full set of variables included in *The Jacksonville-Area Community Assessment* survey. Some of these variables have been recoded. Variable response options with fewer than five responses have been suppressed to protect the privacy of survey respondents.

Responses on each variable are also provided for specific subsamples across demographic groupings based on race and ethnicity (African American or Black, non-Hispanic in comparison to white, non-Hispanic), gender identity (gender minority in comparison to cisgender), sex assigned at birth (female in comparison to male), and age (ages 55 and older in comparison to ages 18 to 54). Responses between each subsample that are statistically significant are noted in the following column with a single asterisk, denoting statistical significance at the 95% confidence level.
